## How to Play:

Print all the pages.

Laminate them and cut out all the cards.

Deal the cards equally among the students. One student starts by choosing one of their cards, and says, "I have a broom. Who has a chair?"

That student places their card, face up, in the middle.

The other students look at their cards to find the chair. The student who has the chair says, "I have a chair. Who has a table"?

Play continues until all the cards are placed in the middle.

The winner is the student to finish their cards first.
